Answers in Genesis has bravely announced that May is the month in which they are "Taking Dinosaurs Back." They believe they are setting the record straight on dinosaurs, and their belief that dinosaurs and man lived together just 6,000 years ago.

To examine their claim, let's look at Ken Ham's article dated 9 May. It is titled "We've Invaded Their "Temple"! (answersingenesis.org/us/newsletters/0505lead.asp).

Claim #1: "Evolutionists absolutely hate it when AiG uses dinosaurs to proclaim the falsity of the idea of evolution and the truth of the history in Genesis." Evolutionists don't hate it...they laugh at the idea that supposed scientists can so badly misuse science to prove their own agenda, when not one shred of evidence supports dinosaurs having lived only 6,000 years ago. In reality, what they do hate is the "misuse of science" (which is synonymous with "young earth creationism").

Claim #2: "Unfortunately, most people equate dinosaurs with millions of years and the evolution belief system." And rightly so! If most people equate dinosaurs with millions of years, it goes to show that our educational system is doing an excellent job! One hundred percent of the evidence shows that dinosaurs lived millions of years ago. Evolution is still a debatable topic, and you can believe God created the world over millions of years, with or without evolution, so the choice is yours on this issue.

Claim #3: "This has occurred because the church—by and large—handed dinosaurs over to the "world" when they abandoned the literal history so clearly communicated in Genesis and allowed belief in millions of years and evolutionary ideas..." Ham blames the church for the church's problems...only there is no problem here! A literal reading of Genesis supports millions of years, with or without evolution. The problem is not that millions of years violates the teaching of Scripture...the problem is that millions of years violates Ham's interpretations of the Scriptures. Fortunately, we are being judged by God, not Ham.

Claim #4: "we have invaded your evolutionary temples, and we have gone into your "holy of holies." For some unknown reason, Ham thinks young earth creationists are a force to be reckoned with. He says they are taking dinosaurs back from evolution. Go ahead, make all the claims you want...the evolutionists are not listening, but your saberrattling will sound impressive to your followers.

Claim #5: "it's not ridiculous to believe dinosaurs and people lived at the same time (as the Bible makes very clear)..." Yes, it is...just check out the resources on this website,

Claim #6: The Crocodile Argument: Just because crocodiles were around during dinosaur time, and crocs and man are together now, it does not in any way imply that dinosaurs and man were together. Just because an animal is unchanged over millions of years, it does not disprove evolution. Evolution allows for a species to remain unchanged. Conclusion

Ken Ham states that "Nothing in observational science contradicts the obvious conclusion based on the Bible's history." He is correct, but his sub-points contain erroneous supporting data. The data below is correct.

- The Bible supports a millions of years old earth
- There is absolutely no geologic evidence for a global flood that killed all the dinosaurs
- There were certainly no dinosaurs on the ark (we would be extinct if there were! See Noah's Ark Does Not Prove a Young Earth, www.answersincreation.org/ark1.htm).
- There isn't a single piece of evidence to show that dinosaurs and man lived together

Evolutionists are not quaking in their boots, for fear that dinosaurs will be thought to be 6,000 years old. (They may be quaking, but it is from their laughter!) Ham's claim that they are Taking Dinosaurs Back is the most empty claim to come out of young earth creationists in many months.

Although Ken Ham is sincere and really believes what he is saying, Christians should not blindly follow the teachings of one who so blatantly ignores science (See Young Earth Evidences). In reality, young earth creationists are not "taking dinosaurs back"...young earth creationists are being "taken" on a science fiction trip...we can only pray that they will come down to earth and realize the truth, and abandon the false teachings of young earth creationism.

You need not fret, however...you can believe in an inerrant, literal Genesis, and believe that the earth is billions of years old. Your salvation is not affected by the age of the earth.
