## TTMCLS – Things That Make Christians Look Stupid – Mr. Hinton's article on Snake Legs By Greg Neyman © 2006, Old Earth Ministries

One of the series of articles on Creation Science Evangelism website (the "Hovind" site) is creatively titled "Things that make evolutionists look stupid" (TTMELS for short). The subtitle then goes on to introduce the topic for the article. The article we shall consider in this commentary is "Snake Legs". <sup>1</sup>

## Snake Legs

At issue here is anal spurs, which are a pair of tiny claws found on each side of the vent of pythons, boas, and other primitive snakes. Hinton argues that these claws are not well understood, but appear to be related to sexual function.
